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## Evidence-based Protocols

We use only hard-sided hyperbaric chambers. All research into hyperbaric oxygen therapy and approvals by the AMA, FDA, and Medicare, are based on HBOT performed in hard chambers, where patients are pressurized to 2.0 to 2.8 ATA and receive 100% oxygen. Research does not support the use of soft chambers. Soft chambers do not heal radiation damage or other serious conditions, such as non-healing wounds, and are not FDA or Medicare approved.

We could, but choose to not, use soft chambers.

Our physicians, nurses and technicians follow specific treatment protocols approved by Medicare, the UHMS, and leading peer-reviewed research in the field.
